I am current Chair of the bi-monthly **Benefice Forum**. The last meeting was held at St Andrews (Photo; top right) and was an **review of the last 3 years 'Interim period'** led by the Archdeacon of Maidstone. It seemed to go very well and made me think how far we have come. This year saw a very successful **Annual Benefice Service** on the sea front, the first for some time which was well attended and collectively peacefully put together across the team led by two lay members from different church traditions. The practice of Churchwardens reporting back at each meeting means that all know what is going on and **cross fertilization and links happen in an organic way**. A **new Benefice Logo** is being created – as Guston parish have moved to Bewsborough leaving a clearer sense of **4 town churches with coastal urban remit**. Revd Melissa has very successfully piloted **Bubble Church** at Charlton Church with a cross-benefice team and this will roll out across the Benefice over time.

This will be my last article as I leave the Dover Benefice on 9 June as my Interim period draws to a close. We have come immensely far together, and I give you all much thanks. A new Team Vicar and Team Rector are on their way! I will not be that far away – and hope you will visit me in Ramsgate when you find yourself in that direction.
